## PROTRACTED DELAYS UNDERMINE U.S. GLOBAL


Permitting delays impair and discourage investments in mineral mining projects.

Despite being blessed with a vast reserve of mineral resources, the U.S. only accounts for 7 percent of world-wide spending on mineral exploration.

Access to minerals means a more secure America. Today, less than half of the mineral needs of U.S. manufacturing are met from domestically mined minerals, forcing U.S. manufacturers to rely on mineral imports.

# LENGTHY PERMITTING PROCESS STALLS ECONOMIC OPPORTUNITY

The length of the permitting process causes mining projects to lose value, stunting economies and job creation.
